Direct Debits

- Please include an email address if you have one.
- The Guild collects Direct Debits on the 1st of each month. Forms must be returned by the 5th of the month before the Direct Debit is due to be collected.
- We collect Direct Debits on the 1st of the month - or on the first working day of the month if the 1st falls on a weekend or public holiday.
- Tick the boxes for parts of your membership subscription you would like to be included in your Direct Debit.
- Please provide all the required information regarding your bank and your bank account
- Please ensure that you have signed AND dated the form.
- Please do not write anything in the Reference boxes
- Return the form as a high res scan or jpeg by email to membership@quiltersguild.org.uk

Please note: If you have already joined a specialist group and paid for it by cash, cheque, online, etc., we cannot automatically add this to your Direct Debit instruction. You will need to complete and return a new Direct Debit form that confirms everything you want to be included on your Direct Debit.

We will write to you by email with at least 10 working days' notice confirming when the payments are due (we will write to you using post if you do not have an email address). You can cancel your Direct Debit at any time – please do this with your bank and please advise us that you have done so.

The Direct Debit Guarantee



- This Guarantee is offered by all banks and building societies that accept instructions to pay Direct Debits
- If there are any changes to the amount, date or frequency of your Direct Debit, The Quilters' Guild will notify you 10 working days in advance of your account being debited or as otherwise agreed. If you request The Quilters' Guild to collect a payment, confirmation of the amount and date will be given to you at the time of the request
- If an error is made in the payment of your Direct Debit, by The Quilters' Guild or your bank or building society, you are entitled to a full and immediate refund of the amount paid from your bank or building society
 - If you receive a refund you are not entitled to, you must pay it back when The Quilters' Guild asks you to
- You can cancel a Direct Debit at any time by simply contacting your bank or building society. Written confirmation may be required. Please also notify us.
